

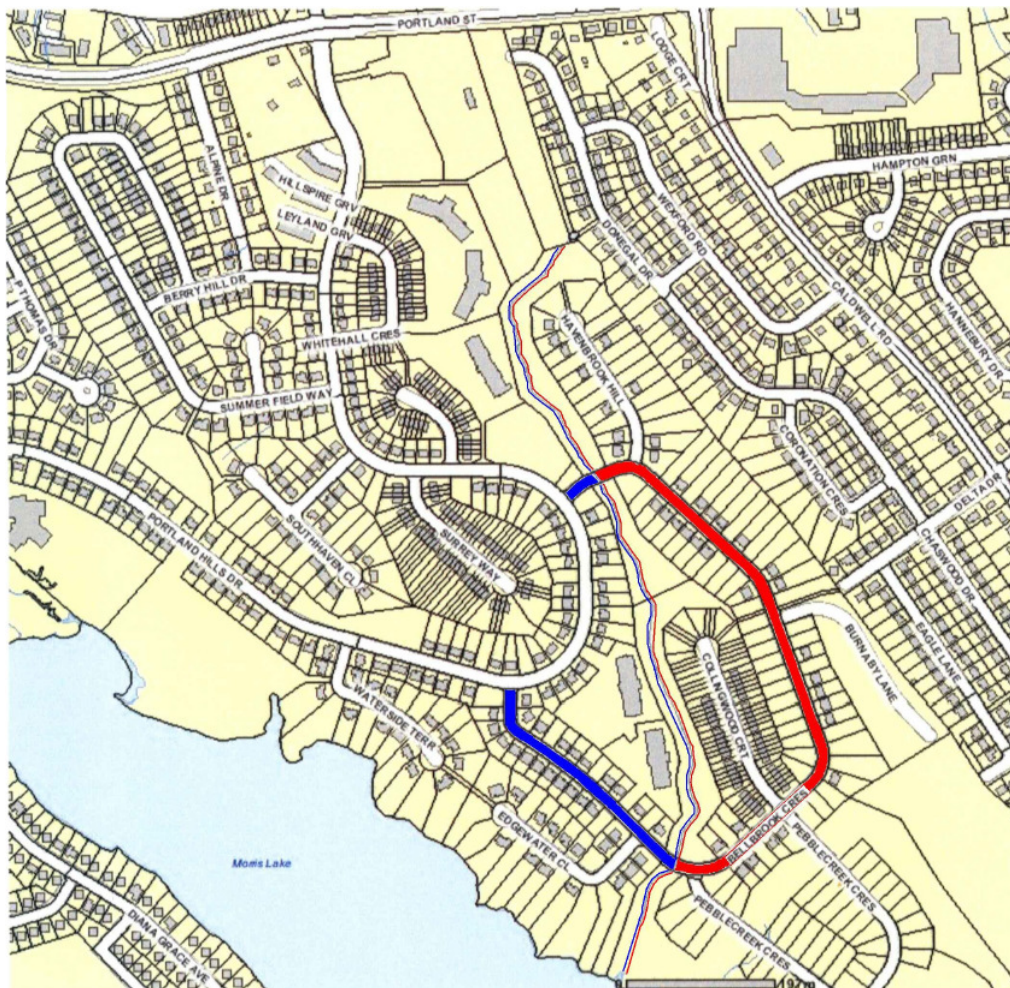
Minor hockey boundary clarification – Bellbrook Crescent area

The boundary between the Dartmouth Whales MHA and the Cole Harbour Bel Ayr MHA in the area of Portland Hills is defined by the brook that runs from Bell Lake to Morris Lake. When DWMHA and CHBAMHA agreed the boundary would be defined by the physical geography of the brook there was no housing being constructed in the Portland Hills area. This has now changed, and as the area has been developed it is apparent clarification of the boundary is needed.

Residents whose address is between 1 and 123 Bellbrook Crescent reside in the Dartmouth Whalers MHA district. Residents whose address is between 124 and 340 Bellbrook Crescent reside within the Cole Harbour Bel Ayr MHA district.

Residents of Bellbrook Crescent (from 124 – 340) not registered with the Dartmouth Whalers MHA before the 2010 -2011 season are required to register with the Cole Harbour Bel Ayr MHA.

Residents who have played with the Dartmouth Whalers prior to the 2010 – 2011 season while living on Bellbrook Crescent (124 – 340) will be permitted to either (i) register with Cole Harbour or (ii) continue to play with Dartmouth Whalers until their children have finished playing minor hockey.
